### **Hysan Development Aims to Have Lee Gardens become a Fully-Vaccinated Community**

*Taking the Lead in Promoting COVID-19 Vaccinations Among  
Our Stakeholders*

Hysan Development is keen to have Lee Gardens become a fully-vaccinated community for the benefit of all those who live, work and flourish in the area.

The Company is proud to announce four vaccination promotion projects to encourage COVID-19 vaccination. The projects will also aid those in Hong Kong beyond Lee Gardens who may be adversely affected by the virus. These programmes all serve to provide a holistic package to bring home the importance of vaccination for the community.

### **Supporting the Community through Promotion of COVID-19 Vaccines**

#### Adventist Health X Hysan Vaccination Promotion Programme

To help our stakeholders become inoculated as soon as possible, we have teamed up with Adventist Health. Both parties will contribute 1,000 health check packages in total primarily to those who are either working on the frontline in the service industry or who are underprivileged members of the Lee Gardens community, with the aim of encouraging vaccination.

In 2014, Adventist Health further extended its healthcare services into the community, offering one-stop services in general medicine and specialist areas including out-patient services, surgery, diagnostic screening, health assessment, and health education.

The two parties have set up Hong Kong's first Vaccination Promotion Centre in a retail complex, situated at the easily accessible Leighton Centre. Those who receive the free health check packages, as well as walk-in members of the public who pay for their own check-ups, can learn more about their health status in preparation for vaccination. The Centre will operate daily from 9:30 am to 6:30 pm (excluding Saturdays). Appointments/Enquiries: 9316 7110

## Lee Gardens Tenant Vaccination Drive and Po Leung Kuk Donation Programme

To encourage more staff among the commercial tenants of Lee Gardens, as well as Hysan staff, to get inoculated, Hysan will make a charitable donation of \$100 for each staff member working in the Lee Gardens Area who has completed his/her vaccinations (two doses) by 30 September 2021.

All proceeds from this drive will be donated to Po Leung Kuk. The donations will be used to fund free body check (blood pressure, cholesterol & diabetes screening) of the elderly aged 60 or above, eligible students and their families at the Kuk's Integrated Health Centres as a means to encourage vaccination. Part of the donation will be used towards providing emergency financial assistance to families suffering hardship due to COVID-19.

## **Maintaining the Vaccination Momentum Among Hysan Staff**

### Health Check and Extra Days-Off

Hysan's colleagues have been proactive when it comes to getting vaccinated. To maintain the vaccination momentum, Hysan is offering health check packages to members of staff who would like to know more about their own health status in preparation for vaccination.

Hysan will also offer two extra days off to staff who have completed their vaccinations (two doses) if the rate of vaccination among staff members reaches 70%.

## **Showing Appreciation for Members of the Public who have been Inoculated**

### Vaccination lucky draw

In a further effort to support the city's COVID-19 vaccination drive, Hysan will launch a four-week lucky draw in August designed to promote our vaccination programme. Lee Gardens Club members who have been vaccinated can enter the lucky draw for the chance to win wellness-related products and services, such as a staycation package, Apple Watch, sports gear or free fitness centre membership.

Lee Gardens Club members who have completed two vaccine injections can simply register online to enter the draw, without any spending requirements. For more details about the lucky draw, please stay tuned to our announcements.
