Air Purifiers and Care Packages From Hysan Development Ready for Those in Need in To Kwa Wan

The 5th wave of Covid-19 in Hong Kong has caused much hardship among businesses in the city, as well as the elderly and underprivileged members of the community.

With a clean and safe environment being a key element both for those serving and those being served, at least 250 medical grade air purifiers will be donated by Hysan to these service providers. Aurabeat, the local scientific technology company specialised in air purification, is also supporting this donation with discounts on the machines and will include extra free filters for the recipients to use. St. James' Settlement is Hysan's partner to connect and deliver the machines to those in need.

Nat, a noodle shop owner who is one of the recipients of the air purifiers, says, "The pandemic has not only affected the businesses but also brought disruption to the public's normal lives. We and some others insist on keeping our doors open during Covid-19 and hope that the neighbourhood will not come to a standstill. Mutual support is the right way to defeat the pandemic. Thank you Hysan for your help!"
