HONG KONG, November 12, 2025 – VILLA LUCCA is a low-density luxury seaview<sup>1</sup> residence jointly developed by Hysan Development Company Limited and HKR International Limited. Perfectly located at the prestigious Tai Po hillside along Lo Fai Road, the highly anticipated development is set against the Pat Sin Leng range<sup>1</sup> and commands breathtaking panoramic views of Plover Cove Reservoir<sup>1</sup> and Tolo Harbour<sup>1</sup>. Today, media were invited for an exclusive first look at two Signature Houses, the largest and most prestigious furnished villas of the residence – No. 1 Villa Avenue<sup>4</sup> and No. 1 Lucca Avenue<sup>4</sup>.

Ms. Jessica Yip, Director of Office and Residential at Hysan Development Company Limited, said, "House No.1 Villa Avenue<sup>4</sup>, VILLA LUCCA, stands out as a one-of-a-kind multigenerational detached house<sup>15</sup> in the district. This house<sup>4</sup> offers captivating views of Tolo Harbour<sup>1</sup> seamlessly blending the sea and sky and framed by majestic mountains<sup>1</sup>. With a total saleable area of 6,268 sq ft<sup>2</sup>, the villa comprises a main house<sup>4,15</sup> and an adjacent detached house<sup>4,15</sup> ideally suited for multigenerational families. The landscape design, meticulously crafted by the renowned landscape design firm ALN, draws inspiration from the classic gardens of Tuscany<sup>5,6</sup>, Italy. On the ground floor of the main villa<sup>4,15</sup>, the family lounge is connected<sup>6</sup> to the detached house<sup>4,15</sup> via a covered corridor and a shared garden, creating a living space that blends seamlessly with the natural surroundings. The villa is furnished<sup>5</sup> with elegant, contemporary pieces that complement the layered greenery outside, harmonising built form and the natural environment. Designing for residents with global perspectives, the architects refined complexity to its essence, delivering understated luxury for those who value refined taste and exceptional quality of living."

**Ms. Yip** further stated, "**VILLA LUCCA** is distinguished by its access to outstanding educational amenities, making it especially suitable for large families with diverse needs. Residents can reach the main entrance gate of The Education University of Hong Kong in about a three-minute drive<sup>11,13</sup>; within a 21- to 38-minute drive<sup>11,13</sup> they can access top institutions such as The Chinese University of Hong Kong, The Hong Kong University of Science and Technology and The University of Hong Kong; and in about a 12- to 15-minute drive<sup>11,13</sup> they can reach well-known international schools such as Malvern College of Hong Kong and the American School Hong Kong. With many prestigious educational institutions nearby, the area offers rich academic resources, allowing families to support their children's academic development while also fostering opportunities for family business growth, enriching the prospects of this residence as an ideal home."

Ms. Pandora Chan, Assistant General Manager of Sales and Marketing at HKR International Limited, said, "House No.1 Lucca Avenue<sup>4</sup> is the largest luxury villa within the VILLA LUCCA development. This grand garden house boasts a saleable area of 8,030 sq ft<sup>2</sup> and six ensuite bedrooms<sup>4</sup>. The ground-floor living and dining area spans nearly 1,300 sq ft<sup>2</sup>, complemented by front and rear gardens totalling approximately 2,767 sq ft<sup>2</sup>, together with a rooftop garden of around 1,349 sq ft<sup>2</sup> – offering an impressive total outdoor space of around 4,116 sq ft<sup>2</sup>. The master suite, measuring 940 sq ft<sup>2</sup>, features dual terraces of nearly 300 sq ft<sup>2</sup>, creating a generous private retreat of more than 1,230 sq ft<sup>2</sup>. The other five suites, each with a balcony or terrace<sup>16</sup> or more, range from approximately 260 to over 600 sq ft<sup>2</sup>. The interior design theme, "Grove Manor — Prestigious Club-Inspired Luxury Amidst Mountains and Sea1", reflects a seamless blend of Eastern and Western aesthetics with natural fluidity. Rounded corners and soft lines flow throughout the residence, creating a harmonious ambience. The dining area continues the wood-and-stone motif<sup>5,6</sup>, and adjoins a jade-inspired stone bar<sup>5,6</sup> equipped with a SUB-ZERO wine cabinet and nitro-chilled glass chillers<sup>5,6</sup>. The kitchen is fitted with a premium Italian Officine Gullo hood and cooker, along with 17 high-end Gaggenau appliances<sup>5,6</sup>.

Arriving at the impressive 1,526 sq ft² wine-cellar-inspired underground garage¹6, guests ascend via private lift through each level of refined elegance. Every space has been thoughtfully crafted to create a private, club-style luxury lifestyle where residents can host elegant gatherings with family and friends. The design embodies a life of balance and poise, creating a legacy home for generations."

Ms. Chan added: "VILLA LUCCA enjoys the advantages of the Hong Kong–Shenzhen 'Twin Cities, Three Circles' development framework. In addition to local end users, there are also signs of a growing proportion of mainland and non-local buyers. As the Northern Metropolis<sup>3,10</sup>—Hong Kong's future growth engine—continues to advance, the project is strategically positioned within both the Eco-recreation and Tourism Circle and the Hong Kong-Shenzhen Close Interaction Circle<sup>8</sup>. Its proximity to the Hong Kong Science Park places it next to the Eastern Knowledge and Technology Corridor<sup>8</sup>, a significant advantage. Driving from the development, it takes around 25 minutes<sup>11,13</sup> to reach Heung Yuen Wai and Lok Ma Chau control points, enabling seamless access to the Hong Kong-Shenzhen metropolitan network. Travel is highly convenient: Central, Tsim Sha Tsui, and the Kai Tak Cruise Terminal are all roughly 31 to 40 minutes drive away<sup>11,13</sup>; while Hong Kong International Airport is about a 43-minute drive<sup>11,13</sup>."

"Over the past year, 'VILLA LUCCA' has seen heightened transaction activity. Since last September, within 14.5 months, it has sold more than 77 units<sup>7</sup>, realising proceeds of over 2.09 billion<sup>7</sup>. ### Grove Manor<sup>1</sup> — Prestigious Club-Inspired Luxury Amidst Mountains and Sea<sup>1</sup>

House No. 1 Lucca Avenue<sup>4</sup> stands as the most expansive residence in **VILLA LUCCA**, a three-storey architectural masterpiece that redefines hillside luxury. Its interior design, themed "Grove Manor<sup>1</sup> — Prestigious Club-Inspired Luxury Amidst Mountains and Sea<sup>1</sup>," blends refined aesthetics with meticulous attention to detail and spatial flow, creating an understated yet commanding ambience of luxury and comfort.

Surrounded by lush greenery<sup>1</sup> across three levels<sup>4</sup>, the journey from the garage<sup>16</sup> to the rooftop terrace<sup>4</sup> is designed to emulate an ascent through forested slopes to a mountain peak<sup>5,6</sup>. The via. architecture limited design team seamlessly integrates the interior design with the natural environment creating a continuous narrative of exploration and elevation.

The ground-level main entrance opens to an impressive double-height foyer (around 7m). A bronze-finished door enriched with linear textures<sup>5,6</sup> is flanked by wave-patterned glass panels<sup>5,6</sup>, offering both privacy and filtered views of the external reflecting pond and garden path, gently drawing the outdoors inside.

### Basement: Castle-Style Wine-Cellar-Inspired Garage<sup>4,16</sup>

Residents arriving by car are welcomed into a uniquely designed European castle-style wine cellar garage. Accessed via a private gate, this expansive 1,526 sq ft² space caters to collectors of luxury automobiles, reflecting distinguished status. Continuing the retreat concept, the entrance from the garage features a dark coffee-toned wood-textured wall on the left⁵,⁶, while light beige travertine flooring and wood-panelled walls on the right⁵,⁶ guide the way. A smoked oak circular staircase⁵,⁶ winds upwards, inviting residents on a journey of discovery through this "mountain sanctuary".

#### **Ground Floor: Living and Dining Areas**<sup>16</sup>

The living and dining areas open onto front and rear gardens, with a total area of over 4,000 sq ft<sup>2</sup>. The light beige travertine flooring<sup>5,6</sup> flows from the basement to the ground floor, unifying the spaces. The approximately 720 sq ft<sup>2</sup> living room opens onto a vast garden. Its interior reflects an Asian-inspired aesthetic where ceiling lines, framing, and elongated glass lighting create a sense of openness and calm<sup>5,6</sup>. The area is divided into two distinct zones:

one features a large beige sofa facing a bronze-brown metallic feature wall concealing the television for a clean aesthetic<sup>5,6</sup>; the other emphasises natural stone<sup>5,6</sup>, with metal-accented wallpaper, a feature wall with deep green and silver-grey woven fabric panels that echo natural leaf textures, and wooden shelving<sup>5,6</sup> for art. A grey stone-textured carpet and coffee tables anchor a relaxed gathering space<sup>5,6</sup>. Floor-to-ceiling glass doors bring in natural light and open to the private garden.

The 570 sq ft² dining room on this level opens to over 2,767sq ft² of front and rear gardens, extending the wood-and-stone design palette from the living area<sup>5,6</sup>. A hand-carved wooden panel depicting a mountain village scene<sup>5,6</sup> creates visual interest, while a glass chandelier, above a 12-seater white marble dining table<sup>5,6</sup>, lends a refined, castle-like elegance. Adjacent is a jade-stone bar area equipped with a SUB-ZERO wine cabinet and nitro-chilled glass chillers<sup>5,6</sup>. The spacious 300+ sq ft² kitchen features Arclinea cabinetry, an Officine Gullo hood and cooker, together with 17 state-of-the-art Gaggenau kitchen appliances<sup>5,6</sup>. Officine Gullo<sup>5,6</sup>, hailing from Florence, carries forward 19th-century traditions with entirely handcrafted creations, are veritable works of art. The washroom on the ground floor is finished in green onyx, complemented by a sculpted mirror and bamboo-inspired metal fittings<sup>5,6</sup>, cultivating an atmosphere of refined luxury. This generous entertaining space extends naturally from indoors to outdoors, harmonising opulence and simplicity, classical elegance and modern sensibility.

### **Ground Floor: Family Fitness Suite<sup>16</sup>**

The family room on this level is configured as a private fitness suite, equipped with a treadmill, exercise bike, and strength-training facilities<sup>5,6</sup>, allowing workouts with garden views<sup>1</sup>. It also features an independent bathroom and sauna<sup>5,6</sup>, for immediate relaxation after exercise, offering a convenient and efficient lifestyle experience.

### First Floor: Four Ensuite Bedrooms and a Multi-Functional Entertainment Room<sup>16</sup>

A staircase with a wooden handrail<sup>5,6</sup> leads to the first floor, home to four ensuite bedrooms, each with a generous wardrobe area, arranged around a compact bar<sup>5,6</sup>. Each suites reflects a quiet sense of luxury with its own distinct personality. Ceilings combine lacquer, leather, and wood finishes<sup>5,6</sup>. Bathrooms feature distinctive combinations of bronze, natural stone, and bespoke metal light fixtures<sup>5,6</sup>, practical yet opulent. A spacious multi-functional entertainment room on this floor, adjacent to the suites, provides immediate access to leisure and relaxation.

#### Second Floor: Master Suite and Children's Realm<sup>16</sup>

The second floor hosts the 940 sq ft² master suite, commanding sweeping views of Tolo Harbour. It features nearly 300 sq ft² of dual terraces, creating a generous total area of over 1,200 sq ft². The entrance showcases a polished stainless-steel sculpture by Hong Kong artist Lee Chin-fai<sup>5,6</sup>. The interior employs Asian-inspired materials and tones<sup>5,6</sup>, with woven wood flooring<sup>5,6</sup> and custom furniture, including a Turri leather bed<sup>5,6</sup>, a TRNK armchair<sup>5,6</sup>, and a DeMuro Das Corbu bench<sup>5,6</sup>, for ultimate comfort and elegance. The master bathroom

features Sichuan White Bamboo marble<sup>5,6</sup>, its fine veins reminiscent of Chinese ink paintings. Adjacent to the sunlit sitting area is a children's bedroom adorned with playful elements, featuring rounded furniture corners for safety and warmth. This 260 sq ft<sup>2</sup> children's suite also connects to nearly 300 sq ft<sup>2</sup> of dual terraces, emphasising a fluid charm of space.

### **Roof Terrace: Outdoor Garden<sup>16</sup>**

The approximately 1,349 sq ft² rooftop terrace garden is equipped with barbecue facilities<sup>5,6</sup>, a 10-seater outdoor dining set, and a sunbathing area. Commanding elevated views of Plover Cove Reservoir and Tolo Harbour¹, it embodies a life of broad-minded ease and distinctive resort-style aesthetics.

### Living in Harmony – Detached Villa with Annex by Mountain, Sea and Gardens<sup>1,15,16</sup>

Another distinguished garden house<sup>4</sup> at **VILLA LUCCA** is House No. 1 Villa Avenue. This rare villa<sup>1</sup> with annex is designed around the concept of harmonious co-living. Through panoramic balconies and terraces, landscaped courtyards, and an annex <sup>1</sup> layout, the residence achieves seamless indoor-outdoor integration, balancing private and shared spaces to showcase luxurious living embraced by mountains and sea.

With the main house rising three storeys in an elegant "L"-shaped configuration, the villa is inspired by Tuscan gardens, features a rare connected guest house design thoughtfully conceived for multigenerational living. The villa features a 2,404 sq ft<sup>2</sup> garden, a 590 sq ft<sup>2</sup> flat roof, a 983 sq ft<sup>2</sup> roof, and a 1,064 sq ft<sup>2</sup> European castle wine cellar-style garage with space for three cars. It is equipped with a private elevator, offering both privacy and luxury.

Embraced by greenery<sup>1</sup> and featuring a front reflecting pond<sup>1</sup>, the house offers a tranquil setting. The ground floor living and dining area<sup>16</sup> stretches over 13 metres in length, spanning more than 850 sq ft<sup>2</sup>. Its interiors are designed by renowned British architecture and interior design firm Conran and Partners. Marble-textured walls are paired with ink-wash paintings<sup>5,6</sup>, while a cascading chandelier<sup>5,6</sup> illuminates a 10-seater table<sup>5,6</sup>. The living room includes a cloakroom, complete with a garment care system<sup>5,6</sup>. The elongated kitchen is equipped with an ultrasonic vegetable washer, an under-sink food waste disposer<sup>5,6</sup>, and a vacuum packing machine <sup>5,6</sup>. The family sitting area features a six-seater table with island seating<sup>5,6</sup>, and a Mini Bar<sup>5,6</sup>. Full-height glass doors designed by Seattle-based, world-renowned architecture firm

Olson Kundig, bring abundant daylight into the design while protecting the owners' privacy, demonstrating a harmonious fusion of architecture and nature.

### First Floor: Two Suites and a Sitting Room<sup>16</sup>

The first floor comprises two ensuite bedrooms and a sitting room<sup>4</sup>. One bedroom is finished in brown wood grain and paired with geometric blue-grey-and-black tones<sup>5,6</sup>. The other suite employs a palette of varying greens, light wood, and beige tones<sup>5,6</sup>, with an ink-wash mountain painting<sup>5,6</sup> that echoes the mountain-and-sea view outside the window. Both suites include wardrobes and bathrooms with oval bathtubs.

At the other end of this floor is the sitting room<sup>4</sup>, furnished with an orange velvet fabric sofa<sup>5,6</sup>, and children's play facilities<sup>5,6</sup>, which connects to an L-shaped large platform for family gatherings.

#### Second Floor: Oversized Master Suite<sup>4</sup>

The second floor houses an oversized, Japanese-inspired master suite spanning 630 sq ft² featuring light wood tones. Another room on this level serves as a study, themed in sleek black, adding an element of mystery and providing an ideal space for quiet contemplation. Notably, the corridor connecting the master bedroom to the study features a large window framing captivating outdoor views. The designer has intentionally placed a wooden bench and an elegant small round tea table here<sup>5,6</sup>, creating a Zen-like corner for residents to sit and reflect.

### **Roof Terrace: Outdoor Garden<sup>16</sup>**

The approximately 983 sq ft<sup>2</sup> roof offers beautiful sea views<sup>1</sup> amidst surrounding greenery<sup>1</sup>. It is furnished with a large grey seven-seater outdoor sofa (including a daybed design) and two sets of nested round coffee tables<sup>5,6</sup>. The other end features a Japanese-style grey stone table <sup>5,6</sup>, alongside a barbecue grill<sup>5,6</sup>, and an eight-seater long outdoor dining table<sup>5,6</sup>. This space is perfect for gatherings.

### Two-Storey Annex 4,15,16

The main area of the house and the annex are connected via a landscaped courtyard<sup>5,6</sup>. The annex spans approximately 885 sq ft<sup>2</sup> across two floors, featuring an open-plan kitchen, and spacious living and entertainment areas specifically designed for family members or guests in need of privacy.

**VILLA LUCCA**, comprises a total of 262 garden houses<sup>4</sup> and standard units, with saleable areas ranging from 1,010 to 8,030 sq ft<sup>2</sup>. The 36 garden houses<sup>4</sup> have saleable areas from approximately 3,245 to 8,030 sq ft<sup>2</sup>, with layouts ranging from four bedrooms (with 3 or 4 ensuites), to five bedrooms (with 2 or 4 ensuites) and six bedrooms with six bathrooms<sup>4</sup>. There are 160 standard units<sup>4</sup> across 14 five-storey buildings, with saleable areas between 1,078 and 2,526 sq ft<sup>2</sup> and three- to- four-bedroom layouts<sup>4</sup>, each featuring a private lift lobby. Additionally, there are 66 special units\* with garden or roof, including 26 top-floor special

units\* with roof, mostly configured as two units per floor $^4$ , with saleable areas from 2,021 to 3,760 sq ft $^2$ . The 40 special units\* with garden  $^4$  have saleable areas ranging from 1,010 to 2,503 sq ft $^2$ , all featuring two- to- four-bedroom layouts $^4$ , offering particular appeal for those who value generous space.

The clubhouse, CLUB LUCCA<sup>12</sup>, spans 34,000 sq ft and offers around 30 facilities<sup>12</sup>, providing residents with an exclusive, private, and diverse range of lifestyle options.
